# Adult Hockey Leagues – Spring/Summer 2024

Skatetown's Adult Hockey League is for players ages 18 and up offering 7 co-ed recreational divisions divided by skill level. All levels are non-checking with Skatetown and USA Hockey Rules being strictly enforced. Officials are employees of the Ice Hockey Officials of Northern California.



**Divisions** – Divisions are filled on a first come, first served basis. Parity is managed by league management and hand-picked steering committees.

- **Bronze B:** This is the entry level rookie division (players just starting out playing hockey). Games are on Thursday evenings.
- **Bronze A:** Entry Level-Novice. In general, players that take the ice for fun, exercise and excitement. Typically, this is our largest division of beginner hockey players. Games are on Sunday evenings.
- Silver B (Stanley and Wales Conference): Intermediate-Novice. Players who are fairly new to hockey and may have played when they were younger. Many players move to this league after playing in the Bronze divisions after a period of time. Silver B Stanley games are on Monday evenings. Silver B Wales plays on Friday evenings.
- **Silver A:** Intermediate. Players who know the game strategically and have had experience playing in the lower-level leagues or growing up. Games are on Wednesday evenings.
- **Gold:** Intermediate-Advanced. Players who have played high levels of hockey including youth travel, or who have grown up playing for an extended period of time. Games are on Tuesday evenings starting.
- **50 & Older Senior A & B Divisions:** Gold, Silver A/B and Bronze A level players only. Games are on Saturday mornings and afternoons. Pick up a Senior Division flyer for more information.

### Equipment requirements

Full equipment is required including mouth guard, shoulder/shin/elbow pads, hockey pants with padding and hockey gloves. HECC approved helmet: full face cage required for Bronze leagues, full cage or half shields required for Silver A and B; face shields are optional in Gold B. Neck guards are recommended



### New players

Players looking for teams will be placed on a "Free Agent" list and will be contacted by individual team captains who are looking for players. Complete the online free agent form: www.skatetown.biz/Free-Agent

#### Goalie subs

If you are interested in occasionally subbing for a team, but are not registered to a team, you can do this for a \$20 fee which is paid to the rink prior to the game. In order to be part of our "sub goalie list," complete the online goalie sub form and your information which will be given to captains looking for goalies. https://www.skatetown.biz/Goalie-Sub

#### Rosters

Teams paying a team fee can roster up to 18 skaters and a goalie. Only 15 players are permitted on the bench for any game. Teams paying a per player fee may have a maximum of 15 players plus a goalie. League management may place players on teams that pay on an individual basis until maximum number of players is

achieved. Players on roster must be registered and paid to appear on the score sheet. **Rosters will be frozen on May 10, 2024.** 

### Game format

Three 15-minute stop-time periods (game length limited to 75 minutes). Tied games will result in a 4-minute 4-on-4 overtime. If no goal is scored, the final result will be a tie. During playoffs, a 4-minute overtime will be played 4-on-4, then go to a 3-man shootout.

**Spring/Summer 2024 dates & fees- March 11 - August 18, 2024.** The season will consist of 21 games (19 regular season and 2 playoff games.) League team fee \$9,525. Individual fee \$635. Note that Pro Rates are not allowed the first two weeks of the season.

### League Registration

Check with your captain for details. **Deadline for team fee registration: February 26<sup>th</sup>- March 1<sup>st</sup>, dependent upon division.** Individual fee registration opens **March 4<sup>th</sup>.** 

In person registrations for individual fee players will be accepted beginning March 4 ·2024, during office hours 8:30am-5:00pm at the front desk and 5:00pm-9:00pm at the Pro Shop. Forms can be printed off website. Payment plan registration must be done in person. Online registration available

Individual fee payment plan option: A \$20 handling fee is added to the individual fee. To qualify for this payment plan, player agrees to play the entire season and pay the entire league fee. A credit card, with valid expiration date and the cardholder's signature authorizing Skatetown to charge the account for the payments when due is required. If payment is not current, player will not be allowed to participate in the league until fees are satisfied. No cash or check payments allowed.

For all late payments or declined credit cards, a \$30 admin fee will be applied to individual payments.
